REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE GRANTING OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

Candidates must:

- 1. be teachers and members of the Jamaica Teachers' Association;
- be final year graduate students pursuing an accredited Masters or Doctoral programme at U.W.I. UTECH, Northern Caribbean University or another University during the Academic Year 2023-2024;
- 3. be pursuing the programme either full or part-time;
- 4. on completion of the course, continue to teach for at least three (3) academic years.
- 5. not be the recipient of any other Award;
 - Six (6) scholarships will be awarded each year.
- N.B. Where recipient fails to comply with #4 of the above, such a recipient will have breached this agreement and will be expected to refund the Association the entire amount granted for scholarship.
